- Report posts on social media that are abusive towards survivors, women, and others who are more likely to encounter harassment. If the abuse is directed against someone you know personally, take screenshots and make them aware in case they want to pursue legal action.
- When you're looking for casual connections or relationships online, respect the boundaries of your prospective date as you get to know them. Don't send private pictures or sexual messages unless there is mutual agreement to exchange them.
- Become a visible advocate for survivors and the organizations that serve them on Facebook, LinkedIn, and beyond. Share the phone number for your local domestic violence hotline, dispel myths about abuse, and tell the world you believe survivors when they share their experiences.
