Safety advocates are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week in over 170 different languages. The hotline is toll-free, anonymous and confidential. NDVH serves as a resource for domestic violence advocates, government officials, law enforcement agencies and the general public. The hotline can help those experiencing violence at home with creating a safety plan, finding local and national resources, and reaching a sense of hope and optimism.
